## POWER

Power is the ability to make and carry out decisions through force, authority, and influence.

**Force** – is the ability to use resources, numbers, and/or organizations to coerce individuals and groups to accept a decision.

**Authority** – comes from the acceptance by society of the right by some individual or group to make and carry out decisions.

**Influence** – is based on respect for the individual making the decision because of factors like wealth, charisma, special abilities, intellectual capacity, and/or strength of character.
